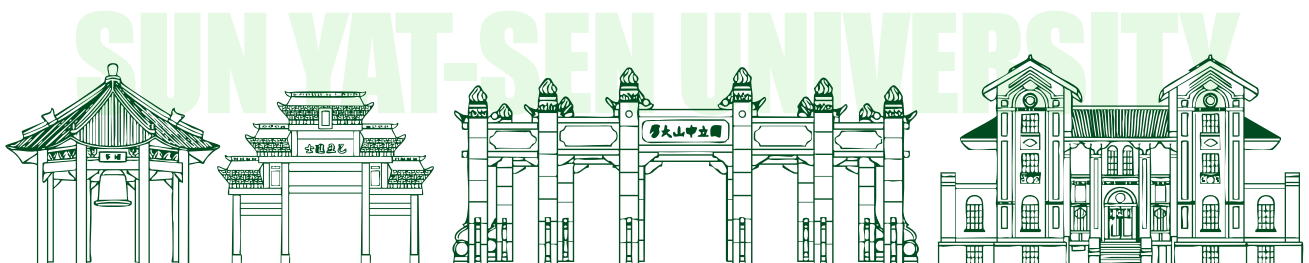
Please note the following important policies regarding transcript issuance:

- **Timely Completion of Assignments:** All assignments, projects, and examinations must be submitted by the specified deadlines. Late submissions without prior approval may result in grade penalties or non-completion of course credits.
- **Transcript Eligibility:** Only students who have met the minimum academic and participation requirements will be eligible to receive an official transcript.
